School Rules

- I come to school at: 7:30 a.m. I go home at 2:00 p.m.
- When the morning bell rings, I stand in my class line quietly.
- When the teacher tells us to move we walk quietly to our classroom.
- I wear the uniform every day.
- I keep my clothes clean and neat.
- I bring the books, the copybooks and workbooks that I need each day.

Classroom Rules

In the classroom:

- I sit quietly in my place.
- I don't move without the teacher's permission.
- I follow the teacher's directions.
- I never talk during the lessons.
- I do my class work neatly.
- I keep my desk clean.
- I don't fight with my peers.
- I raise my hand before I speak.
- I help the teacher to keep the classroom clean and tidy.
- I always speak in English, except in Arabic and French classes.
- I never leave the classroom without the teacher's permission.
- I don't eat or drink in class.

Break Time

In the playground:

- I don't run and push.
- I keep the playground clean.
- I don't fight, shout and scream.
- I never make fun of others.
- I don't play in or near to the bathroom.
- I follow the instructions of the playground supervisors.
- I don't enter the buildings during break time.
- I never throw garbage on the floor.
- If I face any problem, I tell the supervisor or the teacher found in the playground.
- I don't kick or throw my lunch box, backpack, clothing or water bottle.
- I don't say bad words or use body language.
- I respect all the teachers and supervisors.

When the bell rings at the end of the break, I walk (not run) to line up quietly with my classmates.

School Bus

When I Ride The School Bus:

- I stay in my seat and never move around.
- I don't put my hands or my head outside the bus window.
- I don't throw anything from the bus window.
- I don't fight with other students in the bus.
- I don't yell or scream.
- I don't push when I am getting on, or when I am getting down from the bus.

- I never scream.
- I follow the coach's directions.
- I always play with my peers as a team.
- If I become ill during the school day, I tell the teachers or the supervisor and she will take me to the nurse, who will take care of me.

- white/black/ grey or navy-blue shoes (No high heels)

- long blue track
- pink Polo shirt (long enough to cover the hips) (Cuts and see-through T-shirts are not allowed).
- white sneakers

Dress Code (Boys)

Everyday Uniform:

- dark navy-blue trouser
- light blue long-sleeved shirt
- white/black/ grey or navy-blue shoes

P.E Uniform: (to be worn only on the day(s) when P.E is scheduled)

- long black track
- red Polo shirt (Cuts and see-through T-shirts are not allowed).
- white sneakers
