



AMERICAN DIPLOMA PROGRAMS

The American High School Diploma program in Middle East International School (MEIS) aims to provide students with the academic knowledge and skills that prepare them for university education , career success, and personal growth.

Taking the diversity of nationalities and university requirements needed by our students, MEIS aims to prepare students to meet individualized needs that will qualify them to achieve the academic requirements for national, regional, and international universities.

The American High School Diploma or high school degree is an American academic school leaving qualification awarded upon high school graduation.

There are two curricula that our school follows to qualify students for taking the standardized American High School Diploma, namely they are :

A. Common Core (CC) curriculum.

B. Advanced Placement (AP) curriculum

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The Common Core State Standards Initiative, also known as simply Common Core, is an educational initiative from 2010 that details what K–12 students throughout the United States should know in English language arts and mathematics at the conclusion of each school grade.

Based on Common Core standards, there are standardized exams that measure students knowledge and skills .

These exams are :

SAT , ACT , ACT Subject Tests, EST 1, EST 2 ,
SAAT & GAT (قدرات و تحصيلي).



A. Advanced Placement (AP) curriculum

The “Advanced Placement” program offers college-level courses and exams that students can take in high school.

AP exams are offered by College Board, and can be taken in grades 10, 11 , or 12.

Our school curriculum prepares students to take the following AP courses :

- Math: (AP Calculus AB) , (AP Pre calculus)
- AP Physics (1)
- AP Chemistry
- AP Biology
- AP English Language and Composition

In the academic year 2022/2023 , Middle East International School became certified as an AP Exam center.

When to take the AP Exams?

Based on the specific scope and sequence of subjects taught in Middle East International School , students may take the following exams at the grades specified :
